Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has sought another adjournment for filing rejoinder affidavit, which we have declined looking to the circumstances and facts of the case.

2. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having perused the material placed on record, we are not persuaded to grant indulgence to the petitioner-wife of transfer of Family Case No. 160 of 2019 titled as "*Naveen Kumar vs. Neha*" pending before the Family Court, Chirawa, District Jhunjhnu, Rajasthan. This is essentially for the reason that admittedly, another petition seeking custody of the children, as filed by the petitioner, is pending at Chirawa. Though, it is noticed from the submissions made that the petitioner attempted to maintain such a

petition earlier before the Family Court at Hissar, Haryana but, the same was not entertained for want of jurisdiction.

3. It is also noticed from the submissions made by the respondent-husband in the counter affidavit that he is taking care of both the children of the parties. He has further stated his readiness to bear the expenses of the petitioner as also of escort whenever she is required to personally attend the proceedings at Chirawa. This apart, we are inclined to observe that it shall be permissible for the petitioner to make a request for appearance in virtual mode. Such a request, if appropriately made, may be given due consideration.

4. Subject to the observations foregoing, this petition stands dismissed.

5. All pending applications stand disposed of.
