O R D E R

1. This petition is filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of case being MJC No. 2467 of 2024 titled "Dr. Sankalp vs. Dr. Arushi Agrawal", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Allahabad (Prayagraj), Uttar Pradesh to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh.

2. The grounds raised by the petitioner for seeking the transfer are: she has to take care of her minor daughter; and, also on account of long distance, she is unable to effectively defend the proceedings initiated by the respondent at Allahabad.

3. On such consideration, we are of the view that the transfer can be allowed. Consequently, the Transfer Petition is allowed.

4. Accordingly, case being MJC No. 2467 of 2024 titled "Dr.Sankalp vs. Dr. Arushi Agrawal", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Allahabad (Prayagraj), Uttar Pradesh is transferred to the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh.

5. The transferor Court shall forward the records pertaining to the said case to the transferee Court, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Court on 08th September, 2025.

7. The Respondent-husband is permitted to attend the proceedings virtually, unless his presence is required by the trial Court.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
