We do not find any ground to entertain the petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India at this stage, since the matter is pending consideration before the Calcutta High Court.

The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

The Calcutta High Court is requested to decide the matter on merits by getting a report from the Assets Disposal Committee.

Since the apprehension of Mr. P.S. Patwalia, learned senior

counsel for the Petitioners is that the Assets Disposal Committee does not meet frequently on the subject because of the absence of the non-judicial member, it is open for the petitioners to seek appropriate relief before the High Court by making an application for reconstitution of Committee, if they so chooses.
