UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. R.Basant, learned senior counsel for the respondents and having gone through the material on record, we do not find any ground to interfere with the order impugned in the present petitions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has however, submitted that because of COVID-19 pandemic and lock down in the State of Tamil Nadu, the petitioners could not vacate the premises in question within time as undertaken by them before the High Court. He further submits that the petitioners may be permitted some further time to vacate the premises in question on such conditions as may be imposed by this Court.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts of this case, we dispose of these petitions with the direction that the petitioners shall vacate the premises in question on or before 30th September, 2021 on the condition that the petitioners shall pay to the respondents a sum of Rs. 2 lakhs towards rent/damages for the period 01.07.2021 to 30.09.2021.

It is further directed that the petitioners shall file usual undertaking in this Court that they will vacate the premises in question by 30.09.2021 and in case of default, the petitioners shall be liable for contempt of Court.

With the aforesaid directions, these Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
