This Application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner for exemption from surrendering.

Shri S. Nagamuthu, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in the case of a co-accused, exemption from surrendering has been granted.

Petitioner has been convicted under Section 120B read with Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1) (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. The maximum sentence is of 01 year for each offence, the sentences to run

concurrently.

In view of the above, exemption is granted to the petitioner from surrendering.

Application seeking exemption from surrendering stands disposed of accordingly.
