This is a petition filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (for short "CPC"). The petitioner is the wife of the respondent who is her husband. The petitioner has filed this Transfer Petition seeking the following reliefs:

- "1) To allow the present petition of the petitioner and transfer the said case bearing HMA NO.116/2020 titled as Sh. Ajay Khatri Versus Smt. Riya @ Raman Kumari and anr. Pending adjudication Family Court Morena, Madhya Pradesh to appropriate Family Court Faridabad, Haryana.
- 2) To pass any other further other order(s), instruction (s), direction (s) as this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper in present facts and circumstances of case be passed in favour of petitioner and against the respondent."
