O R D E R

The petitioner has moved an application for anticipatory bail before the High Court which was granted on 31.07.2017 on the condition that he would cooperate in the investigation. As the petitioner did not cooperate with the investigation, his anticipatory bail application was rejected by the High Court vide order dated 10.08.2017.

It is stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner that during that period he went to attend his ill sister, who resides in Mumbai, and for this reason he could not join the

investigation. In these circumstances, we permit the petitioner to approach the High Court again with fresh application within two weeks and on filing such an application, the same shall be considered on its own merit.

The petitioner shall not be arrested for a period of two weeks and he is directed to join the investigation also.

In view of the above, the Special Leave Petition shall stand disposed of.
