Mr. G. Sivabalamurugan, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly accepted that the premises in question have already been demolished by the Board and, therefore, basic challenge does not survive.

However, he invited our attention to the Resolution No.9.06 dated 30.10.2019 passed by the Tamilnadu Housing Board to submit that after the re-construction, the petitioner be given chance to occupy the premises in terms of the Resolution.

Learned counsel appearing for the Tamilnadu Housing Board on caveat submits that after re-construction, if an application is made, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

In view of the above, we see no reason to interfere in the matter. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
