Leave granted.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

This appeal has been filed against the interim order dated 20.01.2020 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad in Criminal Misc. Writ Petition No.832 of 2020, by which order the prayer for releasing the appellant on parole to attend marriage of his son has been refused. The High Court has taken the view that the application shall be considered after receipt of response on the next date.

According to the additional documents brought on the record, marriage of Ashish son of the appellant is going to be solemnized on 30.01.2020 and marriage reception is scheduled for 02.02.2020.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant be permitted to attend the marriage and reception of his son in police custody.

We accept the submission of the learned counsel for the appellant and direct that the appellant be released to attend the marriage and reception of his son, in police custody. He shall be released today itself, if possible, and, he will again return to jail on 05.02.2020.

The appeal is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
