O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and carefully perusing the material available on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner.

The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner sought three weeks' time to surrender before the concerned Trial Court, which is granted.

Upon surrender, if the petitioner applies for regular bail, the concerned Trial Court is directed to dispose of the same expeditiously on its own merits and in accordance with law.

We make it clear that for a period of three weeks from today, interim protection is granted to the petitioner.

If the petitioner does not surrender within the stipulated period, as stated above, the order granting interim protection shall stand vacated.

Consequent upon dismissal of the Special Leave Petition, pending applications filed in the matter also stand disposed of.
