O R D E R

SLP (C) No. 15997/2020

We have heard Mr. Mr. Nishant Ramakantrao Katneshwarkar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Rahul Chitnis, learned counsel for the State of Maharashtra and Mr. Sudhanshu Chaudhari, learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 1.

We do not find any good ground to interfere with the impugned judgment and order. The special leave petition is dismissed.

Pending application(s), shall stands disposed of.

The High Court while disposing of the matter vide order dated 3rd December, 2020 issued the following directions :

“C. On submission of the tribe certificate as directed above, the Committee shall endeavour to decide the validation proceedings of the petitioner expeditiously and preferably within a period of four (04) months from the date of submission of tribe certificate by the petitioner.”

It is stated that, so far Scrutiny Committee has not undertaken any exercise. In that view of the matter, we direct the Scrutiny Committee to comply the directions mentioned at Paragraph '19 (C)' of the impugned order within a maximum period of four month's from today.

After compliance of the directions referred above, the Scrutiny Committee shall submit the compliance report to this Court.
