Applications have been filed qua the amount of Rs.15,00,000/-
lying deposited with accrued interest meant for three migrant
workers to be dealt with in a different manner and despite all
efforts no legal heirs of the deceased migrants have been located

since the order was passed on 12.6.2020 i.e. for last three years.

The prayer now made is that this amount be disbursed in equal amount between the SCBA Advocates Welfare Fund and Supreme Court Bar Clerks Association Welfare Fund Trust.

On examination of the matter we find that since no beneficiary is available and three years have passed, no purpose would be served in keeping the amount lying in the deposit. Thus the amount be equally disbursed as aforesaid inclusive of the accrued interest.
