



He only points out that he has filed two applications, one, seeking visitation right of the child, and the other, relating to preservation of call records. He submits that he will move afresh in regard to these applications before the Family Court to which the cases are being transferred and liberty may be reserved to move such applications.

Reserving such liberty to the respondent to move appropriate applications, as advised, and leaving open the contentions of the parties, the transfer petitions are allowed as prayed for.

We only direct that the Family Court will make every effort in disposing of the matters as early as possible.
