Overflow of sewage due to obstruction and dumping of garbage by scrap dealers on the side lines of the open drains due to encroachment by high rise complexes and shops was the subject-matter of OA No.648 of 2019. By an order dated 02.01.2020, the National Green Tribunal issued certain directions for implementation of the recommendations that were made by the Oversight Committee. The O.A. was taken up by the Tribunal on 20.09.2020 to examine whether there was compliance of the directions given in January, 2020 by the Ghaziabad Development Authority, Uttar Pradesh Jal Nigam and Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam.

The present appeal is filed by the Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam aggrieved by the order dated 02.01.2020.

After hearing Mr.Vishwajit Singh, learned counsel appearing for the appellant for some time, we

permit the appellant to withdraw this appeal to approach the National Green Tribunal.

By an order dated 29.09.2020, the Oversight Committee was directed to file a status report. We are informed that the matter is listed for further consideration on 17.02.2021. It is open to the appellant to raise all contentions before the Tribunal. If the appellant is aggrieved by any order passed by the National Green Tribunal, the appellant is at liberty to challenge the same.

The appeal is accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
