Sambalpur Development Authority dated 13.11.2023. A copy of the said letter has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who has agreed to the terms of the letter. The contents of the said letter are relevant to take on record, however, reproduced as thus :-

*The petitioner in the captioned matter has assailed the order dt. 09.11.2020 passed by the Hon’ble High Court of Odisha in WP (C) No. 27853 of 2020 before the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India.*

*In this regard, it is to inform you that the Sambalpur Development Authority has decided to renew the application preferred by the petitioner on production of the same to SDA without imposing the restriction under condition ‘g’ of the permission given by SDA vide letter no. 333/SDA dt. 13.02.2013 and subsequently renewed vide SDA letter no. 922/SDA, dt. 29.02.2016..*

*In this connection, the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India may be requested to allow four weeks time*

*for consideration disposal of the renewal application submitted by the petitioner.*
