O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Satyajit A. Desai, learned counsel appearing  
for the petitioner.

We do not find any good ground to interfere with the impugned  
order. The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.

At this stage, Mr. Satyajit A. Desai, learned counsel  
appearing for the petitioner, has submitted that the petitioner's  
wife is undergoing treatment for her heart ailment and the  
petitioner is facing great hardship because of the recovery of the  
amount at the higher quantum of instalment which is to the extent  
of 50% of his pension amount.

If that be so, the petitioner is at liberty to make a  
representation before the concerned authority to reduce the quantum  
of recovery amount of pension and increase the number of  
instalments accordingly. In case a representation is made in this  
regard, the same shall be considered by the concerned authority as  
expeditiously as possible.
