O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and carefully perusing the material placed on record, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the High Court dismissing the application for anticipatory bail preferred by the petitioners herein.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, at the request of learned counsel, one week time is granted to the petitioners to surrender before the trial court. For a period of one week, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners.

If the petitioners surrender before the trial court within the time stipulated hereinabove and file an application seeking their enlargement on bail, the same shall be considered and disposed of on its own merits and in accordance with law expeditiously.

Consequent upon dismissal of the special leave petition, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
