UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Having regard to the nature of controversy, the  
disbursed amount (Rs.9,25,000/- Rs.Nine lakh & twenty five  
thousand), the year in which it was paid i.e. in 2007 and  
keeping in view the requirement of Section 32 of Negotiable  
Instruments Act, 1881 and with a view to do complete justice  
between the parties concerned, we consider it just and  
proper to direct the petitioner to pay a total sum of  
Rs.13,00,000/- (Rs.Thirteen lakhs) to the respondent within  
a period of three months from today.

Whatever amount which has been so far deposited by the petitioner pursuant to the order of any court in this court during trial shall be adjusted against the amount which we have directed the petitioner to pay to the respondent in respect of the dispute in question towards full and final satisfaction.

Whatever interest which the FDR may have earned on the deposits made as per the order of the court, the same shall also be paid to the respondent.

The Registry of the High Court as well as the trial court are directed to release the amount, if any, deposited in favour of the respondent along with interest. On compliance being made of this order, the direction regarding jail sentence shall stand set aside.

With the aforesaid direction, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
