Heard Mr. Pijush Kanti Roy, learned counsel for the petitioner.

On a perusal of the materials on record, it is evincible that the application preferred under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure in Title Suit No. 20761/2014 is pending for final adjudication before the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Alipore. Keeping in view the nature of the lis involved, we direct the Civil Judge to dispose of the injunction application finally without being influenced by the

views expressed by the High Court in the order dated 2.7.2018 passed in C.O. No. 1620/2018, within four weeks and send the compliance report to the Registry of this Court within six weeks. Be it noted that no further extension of time for disposal of the application shall be granted.
