

Taking into consideration the submissions made by the leaned counsel appearing for the parties and the fact that only few witnesses need to be examined, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

However, we direct the concerned Trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within a period of six months from the date of communication of this order.

In case trial is not concluded within the stipulated period, as stated above, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the Trial Court for grant of bail.

With the above observations the Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the afore-stated terms.

Consequent upon disposal of the Special Leave Petition, pending application filed in the matter also stands disposed of."

Perused the Office Report dated 23-11-2021.

As per the said Office Report, a letter dated 28-9-2021 has been received from the Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rajgarh (Bioara), M.P. enclosing therewith a letter dated 27-9-2021 of the Second District & Additional Sessions Judge, Biaora District, Rajgarh, M.P. requesting therein to extend the time for 8 to 10 months for disposal of the Sessions Case No.454 of 2019.

Taking into consideration the averments made in the said application of Second District & Additional Sessions Judge, Biaora District, Rajgarh, M.P, finally four months' time from today is granted for the said purpose.

It is made clear that no further extension of time would be granted for the purpose.

Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of in the afore-stated terms.
