Mr. D. Kumanan, learned Advocate-on-Record, who is on caveat, accepts and waives formal notice on behalf of the respondent(s).

In the meantime, let the petitioners deposit the entire decretal amount with interest and cost (after deducting whatever the amount is deposited) with the trial Court on or before the returnable date.

It is reported that, by now the petitioners have deposited a total sum of Rs.21,80,000/- out of which the respondent has already withdrawn Rs. 10,00,000/-. The respondent shall be permitted to withdraw the balance amount (the entire decretal amount) on furnishing the security to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, it is clarified that the security shall be with respect to the balance amount i.e. decretal amount minus Rs.10,00,000/-.
