Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered opinion that the cause of justice shall be best sub-served if the appellants in these cases, are extended the benefit from 1.1.1990 to 1.1.1996. We are so directing as we are of the view that there was no necessity to make a distinction between the appellants and the Surveyors in Industry department, for the simple reason that they were treated at par in the Fourth Pay Commission since

1996. Be it clarified, the benefits granted shall be restricted to the appellants in these appeals only.

The appeals are, accordingly, disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
