O R D E R

1. The petitioner - wife seeks transfer of First Appeal No.232 of 2019, titled as "Smt. Aparna vs. P. Durga Prasad", pending before the High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Principal Seat at Jabalpur to the High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi. The above-stated appeal has been filed by the petitioner - wife.

2. The marriage between the parties was solemnized on 26.04.2001 and two daughters born out of the said wedlock, who are 20 and 18 years of age respectively, stay with the petitioner.

3. Notice to the respondent - husband was issued on 01.03.2021 and as per the Office Report, notice has been delivered to him on 16.03.2021 but no one has entered appearance on his behalf so far.

4. Since the petitioner - wife is staying in Visakhapatnam and the respondent - husband is also stated to be presently working in Bharat Petroleum Corporation, Niazabad, Telangana, we allow the instant Transfer petition and order that the First Appeal No.232 of

2019, titled as "Smt. Aparna vs. P. Durga Prasad", pending before the High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Principal Seat at Jabalpur be transferred to the High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi. The records be forwarded to the Transferee High Court forthwith.

5. The High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Amaravathi is requested to dispose of the above-stated appeal in accordance with law expeditiously.

6. As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory application also stands disposed of.
