Additional affidavit has been filed by the respondent in the Court today, which is taken on record.

As per the averments in the additional affidavit and in view of the discussions in court, the respondent acceded to get revaluation done of the language proficiency test of the petitioner in terms of the judgment of the Bombay High Court in

Writ Petition No. 5450/2018 titled "*Neha Rakesh Meshram and others vs. Reserve Bank of India and others*". The Head of Department of Gujarati Language in Gujarat University was requested to depute a Gujarati language Expert for the re-assessment and the name of the candidate was not disclosed nor the numbers. The expert has allocated 32 marks to the petitioner. As per the norms, set forth by the High Court of Bombay, the cut off marks for OBC category to which the petitioner belongs is 45. Thus the petitioner has marks way below that.

In view of the aforesaid, really speaking, the only grievance of the petitioner for revaluation has been met.

Thus, the special leave petition accordingly, stands disposed of.
