O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and carefully perusing the material placed on record, we see no reason to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

The High Court vide impugned order dated 19.06.2020 while rejecting the bail application filed by the petitioner herein already directed the trial court to make all endeavours to dispose of the trial within a period of six months. However, in spite of the said direction, the matter has not been concluded by the trial court.

In view of the above, we grant another three months' time from today to the trial court to conclude the trial in accordance with law.

In case the trial is not concluded within the time stipulated hereinabove, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for bail before the trial court.

Consequent upon dismissal of the special leave petition, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
