## O R D E R

We are not inclined to entertain this special leave petition, same is dismissed.

We, however, observe that it shall be open for the petitioner to contest proceeding under the Hindu Minority Guardianship Act, 1956 and take all such pleas which are permissible in law. We further observe that any observation made in the judgment of the High Court is for the purpose of deciding the habeas corpus petition as the High Court has already refrained from making any

observation on the merits. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the order passed by the High Court is being violated. It is open for the appellant to take such remedy as advised in law.
