UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The Division Bench of the High Court, in paragraph 10 of the impugned judgment, made the following observations :-

"However, this Court further observes that since the respondents being poor people, working as Sweeper-cum-Peons on daily wage basis and have discharged their duties to the satisfaction of the authorities for a period of almost 7 years, as reveals from the facts and records, the Bank authorities shall consider the case of the respondents on a humanitarian ground so that the respondents will not be prejudiced and they will continue further smoothly in the said poses."

These observations are uncalled for. Therefore, these observations made in paragraph 10 of the impugned judgment are expunged.

It is open for the concerned authorities to consider the case of the respondents in accordance with law and on its own merits within four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With these observations, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
