Leave granted.

The appellant has preferred this appeal against the judgment and order dated 1.6.2015, passed by the High Court of Karnataka in M.F.A. No.2201 of 2012, whereby the High Court allowed the appeal partly and enhanced the compensation from Rs.77,000/- to Rs.2,20,000/- with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of the petition till the date of realisation.

We have heard Mrs. Pankaj Bala Verma, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and Mr. Maibam N. Singh, learned counsel appearing for the respondents and perused the record.

Having regard to the circumstances of the case, we are satisfied that the appellant's disability is liable to be re-assessed at more than 15% as was allowed by the High Court. We, accordingly, partly allow this appeal and

modify the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court to the extent that Respondent No.2 - Insurance Company, shall pay a lump sum amount of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees three lakh only) towards compensation to the appellant within a period of three months from today.
