

The petitioner was taken in custody on 30.05.2020 in connection with offences punishable under Sections 409, 468 and 120-B IPC read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. The District & Sessions Judge, Eastern Division-cum-Special Judge, Tezu, Lohit, Arunachal Pradesh, released him on bail vide order dated 04.06.2020.

Heard Mr. Siddharth Dave, learned Senior Advocate in support of the petition.

Considering the circumstances on record, we see no reason to interfere with the order cancelling the bail.

The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Police Station within seven days from today, failing which the investigating machinery shall be at liberty to take him in custody.

We have been apprised that the investigation into the crime is still not complete. We may observe that the investigation be concluded as early as possible.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to file an application for bail after the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is preferred by the Police.

Any observation made by the High Court in the order presently under challenge shall not be taken as reflection on the merits of the matter, which will be gone into independently at every stage.

With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave
Petition is dismissed.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
