O R D E R

The petitioner (wife) seeks transfer of the Divorce case filed by the respondent(husband) pending before the Family Court at Hyderabad to a competent Court in Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh.

Mr. V. Sridhar Reddy, learned counsel, submits that the petitioner was thrown out of the matrimonial home on account of dowry harassment and she is currently residing in her parental home at Rajamahendravaram.

She has filed a complaint under Section 498A and other sections also under the Dowry Prohibition Act before the

Women PS Rajamahendravaram against the respondent and has applied for maintenance.

Her suit for Restitution of Conjugal Rights against the respondent before the Family Court Rajamahendravaram is also pending.

According to the learned counsel, the petitioner is without any earning whereas the respondent is employed with a Central Government organisation with monthly earning of about Rs.60,000/-.

In view of above, let notice, returnable in four weeks, be issued.

In the meantime, there shall be stay of proceedings in F.C.O.P. No. 213 of 2021 titled as *Sri. Kadali Srinivas v. Smt. Dommeti Komalidevi* pending in Family Court at Hyderabad, Telangana State.
