ORDER

This application has been filed on behalf of thirty four workmen. By the judgment of this Court dated 21 November 2016, an amount of Rupees four lakhs each was directed to be paid over to eighty eight workmen concerned in the reference subject to due verification before the Central Government Industrial Tribunal¹ (No.2) Dhanbad in Reference 54 of 1993. Thereafter, by an order dated 17 August 2018, this Court, upon being informed that there was no Presiding Officer at the CGIT (No.2) Dhanbad, requested the District Judge to nominate any judicial officer of the rank of Additional District Judge to implement the directions contained in the judgment dated 21 November 2016.

From the interim application, it appears that fifty four out of eighty eight workmen have received the amount. It appears that thirty four workmen were not able to present their identification documents for verification within time, which was stipulated to be three months by the

order dated 17 August 2018. It has been stated in the interim application that these thirty four workmen were unable to submit their documents in time since they are located in different parts.

In our view, the ends of justice would be met by granting a further extension of three months from today so as to facilitate the completion of the exercise with reference to the balance thirty four workmen by the Additional District Judge, Dhanbad nominated in pursuance of the order dated 17 August 2018. We request the Additional District Judge, who was nominated by the District Judge, to accordingly complete the exercise. In the event that the same learned Additional District Judge is not holding the same post, we would request the District Judge to nominate any other Additional District Judge for the said purpose.

The Miscellaneous Application is disposed of.
