O R D E R

The grievance in this Special Leave Petition is that adhoc amount of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) per month has been determined as compensation amount, whereas the premises in question is an old structure and with only one room accommodation.

In other words, the amount determined by the High Court by way of interim order is excessive and, more so, without giving opportunity to both sides to deal with the said issue.

As this being the grievance in the Special Leave Petition, we deem it appropriate to give liberty to the petitioners to approach the High Court by way of formal application for modification of the condition, which be considered on its own merits and in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
