O R D E R

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner - wife for transfer of H.M.A. No.654 of 2016 titled "Sh. Akash Kumar Singh Vs. Smt. Nishi Singh" from the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court, Gautambudh Nagar, NOIDA, Uttar Pradesh to the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court at Jamshedpur, Jharkhand.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of this case, particularly the fact that the petitioner has one child of three years and, being a resident of Jamshedpur, Jharkhand, she would be put to considerable inconvenience in prosecuting the matter at NOIDA, Uttar Pradesh, we think it appropriate to transfer the aforesaid case from the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court, Gautambudh Nagar, NOIDA, Uttar Pradesh to the Court of the Principal Judge, Family Court at Jamshedpur, Jharkhand.

The transferor court shall forthwith transmit the record of the aforesaid case to the transferee court.

After transfer of the petition, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour either for amicable settlement or for early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments.
