ORDER

Accordingly, these transfer petitions are allowed and Matrimonial Case No. 2501 of 2020, titled as "*Shyam Krishna Jaloo vs. Priyanka Verma*", and Miscellaneous Case No. 276 of 2020, titled as "*Shyam Krishna Jaloo vs. Priyanka Verma & Anr.*", both pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, are hereby transferred to the Family Court, Karkardooma Court, Delhi.

The parties shall be at liberty to apply before the transferee court for appearing through the video conferencing mode.

The records of the case be transferred to the transferee court forthwith.

All pending applications stand disposed of.
