O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, it is directed that the Medical Council of India shall send a team for inspection within three months as per the schedule for the academic year 2018-2019. The application filed by the institution for the academic year 2017-2018 shall be treated as an application for the academic year 2018-2019. The deficiencies noted by the Inspection Committee shall be brought to the notice of the institution, and it shall be granted liberty to remove the deficiencies. Thereafter, the matter shall be placed before the Hearing Committee, if required, after removal of deficiencies, and if any deficiency is still required to be removed, the same shall be removed by the institution, and if the institution is a compliant institution, it shall get the Letter of Permission for the relevant academic year i.e. 2018-2019.

Needless to say that we have passed this order without quashing the orders dated 30.05.2017 and 30.08.2017 but that does not necessarily mean that the Union of India or the Medical Council of India shall place reliance on the same.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms. No order as to costs.
