



Considering the stage at which the instant challenge has been raised, we see no reason to entertain this petition in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 136(1) of the Constitution of India. We, therefore, dismiss this Special Leave Petition.

However, in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case on record, we may observe that the pending enquiry be taken to the logical conclusion as early as possible.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that certain elements which are not purely dependent upon the conduct and conclusion of the enquiry may be released to the petitioner. We see force in the submission. Let the needful be done in that behalf within four weeks from today.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
