SUO MOTU CONTEMPT PETITION (CRL) NO. 4/2017
IN TRANSFER PETITION (CIVIL) NO. 1746/2016

1. We have heard the alleged contemnors who have appeared in-person. We have perused the affidavit dated 20th March, 2017 filed by the alleged contemnors Nos. 1

and 2. Taking into account the statements made in paragraphs 13, 14, and 15 of the aforesaid affidavit dated 20th March, 2017 we accept the unconditional apology offered and drop the contempt proceedings.

2. The contempt petition is disposed of in the above terms.

TRANSFER PETITION (CIVIL) NO.1746/2016 AND
TRANSFER PETITION (CRIMINAL) NO. 375/2016

1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents who appear in-person.

2. We have taken note of the grounds on which the transfer has been prayed for. We are satisfied with the grievance expressed by the petitioner and we accept the same. Therefore, (i) Contempt Case No.138 of 2015, titled as "Trilok Singh & Anr. Versus Harjinder Kaur & Others"

pending before the learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, District Ludhiana, Punjab and (ii) Criminal Complaint Case No.Com/364/2014, titled as "Harjeet Kaur Vs. Harjinder Kaur" pending before the learned Court of Illaqa Judicial Magistrate, District Ludhiana, Punjab are ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Rohini, New Delhi. The learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, District Ludhiana, Punjab and the learned Court of Illaqa Judicial Magistrate, District Ludhiana, Punjab shall send the case record to the transferee Court promptly and without any delay.

3. The transfer petitions are accordingly allowed.

4. After transfer of the petition(s), the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour for amicable settlement,

failing which for early decision in the
case(s) without unnecessary adjournments.
