O R D E R

Though the conviction is under the NDPS Act, the punishment
imposed by the High Court is only imprisonment for a period of five
months and a fine amount of Rs.15,000/-.

Paragraph six of the impugned judgment reads as follows:

"The appellant shall surrender before the Court
concerned on or before 31.12.2020."

Out of the said period of five months, the petitioner has
already undergone imprisonment for 66 days. Therefore, the
exemption from surrendering is granted subject to the petitioner
shall pay the fine amount of Rs.15,000/- within a week, if not
already deposited.
