This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of H.M.O.P.No.66/2017 titled *G. Sivakumar v. S. Sandhya* pending before Subordinate Judge of Ranipet at Tamil Nadu to Family Court at Thalassery at Kerala.
