The petitioners are aggrieved by the order dated 06-09-2019 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad whereby a part of the MACT compensation has been permitted to be withdrawn during pendency of the First Appeal. It appears to us that the effective remedy for the petitioners lies in the adjudication of the main appeal itself so that in the event of affirmation of the award, the entire amount so awarded can be

released in their favour. We, thus, dispose of this special leave petition without interfering with the impugned order with a request to the High Court to decide First Appeal No.1965 of 2018 expeditiously and if need be through Video Conferencing.
