O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we think it appropriate to direct that each of the respondents in the

present contempt petitions shall pay, by way of bank drafts, a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) to the petitioner-Corporation within four weeks hence.

In view of the above, the contempt petitions are disposed of.
