Delay condoned.

It is submitted by Ms. June Chaudhari, learned senior counsel
appearing for the petitioners, that a point was raised before the
High Court with regard to the fact that the similarly situated
persons, which number exceeds 40, have been granted the allotment

after the cut off date but the petitioners have been discriminated.

On a perusal of the order passed by the High Court, we find that there has been no deliberation on the said score. Regard being had to the submission advanced at the Bar, we grant liberty to the petitioners to file applications for review only on this ground within four weeks hence and request the High Court to dispose of the review on merits without throwing it at the threshold on the ground of limitation.

In case the petitioners do not succeed in review, liberty is granted to challenge the main order as well as the order passed in the review.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.
