O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. We have perused the settlement between the parties dated 03.10.2018, arrived at before the Alternative Dispute Resolution Centre, Udaipur.
3. We had expressed our reservations in our order dated 16.08.2019 in respect of part 4(2) of the Settlement that the respondent, father and his parents shall have no right to meet the Child Pajas. This portion reads as under :

"4(2)-Second party Sunny Nagpal and his parents shall not meet Ms.Pajas and shall have no relation with her so that it may not bring adverse effect on the girl emotionally."
4. It is agreed by both the parties that the aforesaid condition be set aside and the remaining

settlement be adopted.

5. We order accordingly.

6. Parties shall remain bound by the settlement, except the portion extracted above.

7. A joint petition for divorce in terms of settlement is undertaken to be filed within two weeks and the Family Court will at that stage, set out the terms for visiting rights of the respondent as well as his parents so as to interact with the child, Pajas.

8. The transfer petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
