



by the petitioners. We are not impressed by this argument.

That expression "errors" has to be read *ejusdem generis* with the previous words permitting only correction of any clerical or arithmetical mistake in the award passed by the Special Land Acquisition Officer. It cannot be invoked to revisit the award and to take a different view or for that matter review of the award which power is not vested in the Special Land Acquisition Officer.

The petitioners have, in any case, invoked remedy of reference against the subject award, in which it will be open to the petitioners to agitate the issue raised in the application for correction under Section 33 of the Act.

It will be open to the petitioners to request the Reference Court to take up the reference application for hearing expeditiously.

The special leave petition is disposed of in view of the above.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
