Though the impugned order speaks that till superannuation, the alternative job be given to respondent (herein). However, the impugned order is interlocutory one and it can be modified at the time of final hearing of the case by the

High Court.

Obviously in case of change in circumstances, it is open to the petitioners to apply for modification of stay as already permitted in the impugned order. In the circumstances, we request the High Court to decide the matter preferably within six months.
