The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has not been paid the arrears as per the order dated 17.01.2019 passed by this Court in SLP (Civil) No.8124 of 2018.

Mr. Sanjay Kharde, learned counsel appearing for the respondent(s)/alleged contemnor(s) submits that an amount of Rs.31 Lakhs has already been paid to the petitioner, which according to them is the only amount due.

If the petitioner has any grievance with regard to incorrect computation of his arrears, he can approach the Joint Director, Higher and Technical Education, Pune for computation of the correct amount, if any.

The Contempt Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid observations.

If such a representation is made, the Joint Director, Higher and Technical Education, Pune is directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within a period of three months from the date of representation.
