O R D E R

Mr. Balbir Singh, learned senior counsel, appearing for the appellant, submits that identical matters assailing the orders of the first respondent, National Financial Reporting Authority, have reached this Court and this Court has already granted interim orders. He submits that the present appeal may also be entertained against the order issuing notice passed by the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (for short, the "NCLAT") and similar relief may be granted.

We are not inclined to accept the request as the appeal is still pending before the NCLAT and 11th July, 2025 is the next date fixed.

Considering the circumstances, we pass the following order:

(i) Liberty is granted to the appellant to apply to the NCLAT for fixing an early date in the pending appeal;

(ii) The appellant shall place all the relevant material, including details of similar matters where interim relief was granted by this Court, and request for similar relief being granted;

(iii) Upon such an application being filed, the NCLAT may consider the same on its own merits; and

(iv) Liberty is granted to the appellant to move the vacation Bench of the NCLAT.

The appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
