O R D E R

The petitioner-wife is before this Court seeking transfer of the Cr1. Complaint No.6902773 of 2018 titled "Devendra Singh Solanki Vs. Jyoti & Ors." pending before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-2, Agra, U.P. to the Competent Court in Nainital, Uttarakhand.

Notice of this petition was issued to the respondent. The respondent has filed objections to the petition.

In the light of the averments made in the petition and the contentions urged in the objection statement, having perused the same we have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

A perusal of the papers indicates that the petition filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is already pending in the Jurisdictional Court in Nainital at Uttarakhand.

In any event, keeping in view the reasons assigned in the petition seeking for transfer, we are of the opinion that the order as prayed is liable to be granted.

The prayer of the petitioner is accordingly granted and it is directed that Cr1. Complaint No.6902773 of 2018 titled "Devendra Singh Solanki Vs. Jyoti & Ors." shall stand transferred from the Court of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-2, Agra, U.P.to the Competent Court in Nainital.

The records of the case be transferred to the Transferee Court forthwith.

Accordingly, the Transfer Petition is allowed.
