Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as also the learned counsel for the respondent and perused the petition papers.

The petitioner as also the respondent are present before this Court.

During the pendency of the instant transfer petition, the parties were referred to mediation to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties. The parties have entered into a settlement by way of a settlement agreement dated 08.04.2023 whereupon, certain terms have been agreed by the parties, and the parties on also realising that the marriage between them has irretrievably broken down and the marital relationship between them cannot be continued, have arrived at the conclusion that the marriage is to be dissolved.

In that view, the Settlement Agreement dated 08.04.2023 is taken on record and made a part of this order.

Since, the terms, as agreed therein, are stated to have been complied, and there is no demand whatsoever pending against each other, in exercise of our power under Article 142 of the Constitution, it is ordered that the marriage between the parties which was solemnized on 06.02.2010 shall stand dissolved. Decree shall be drawn in that regard.
