Heard Mr. Gurinder Singh Gill, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners (defendants). Also heard Mr. P. S. Patwalia, learned Senior Counsel for the respondent (plaintiff).

2. It is seen that the present challenge is against the interim order passed by the High Court on 08.07.2019 and the Special Leave

Petition is pending here since last four years. The concern of the petitioners is that the interim order covers an area beyond the suit land.

3. In response, Mr. Patwalia submits that the above contention can be the subject matter of the final adjudication in the appeal which is pending before the High Court.

4. Noting the above, we deem it appropriate to order for closure of the proceedings. The High Court should proceed with the pending appeal and decide the same on merit.

5. With the above order, the Special Leave Petition is closed.
